Review of Polling Stations.

It was agreed that the we do not need 3 polling stations in the Parish, it would be better if the 5 households who currently go to Caldbeck to vote from our Parish were sent to either Welton or Sebergham polling stations (both are equidistant from their homes). This will save the PC money in the event of us needing to fund an election in the future.

The Police Authority are looking for volunteers to become independent custody visitors. The Clerk has details if required.

Notification of proposed closure of Welton School the notices for the consultation period are being displayed on both notice boards.

It was mentioned that, there are a lot of old records in the school, the Clerk will write to CCC with a copy to the school to ask that the records, photos etc are put in the County archive. It would be nice if there was an exhibition of the photos etc before the school closes, the Clerk will mention this in her letter.

There is also the question of what will happen to the broadband link that currently goes into the school and, ultimately what will happen to the building. As the Parish is part of the NF broadband pilot maintaining the broadband link is extremely important. Whilst the PC are not "in the market" for the building it has definite potential to be used as a community resource and, as such the PC would like to be included in any discussions re the sale or demolition of the building.

7. PARKING IN CHURCHTOWN

Mr Little has been keeping most of the vehicles off the roadside. There does not appear to have been much progress re the Planning Application. The Clerk will contact Allerdale and see what progress has

been made. The Clerk will also write to Mr Little and ask what progress has been made re the planning application, we hope that there will be some movement on this before the next meeting.
